

2019 Carmichael Weekend Jam

RULES & GUIDELINES

Thank you for participating in Carmichael U10/U12 Weekend Jam!
This event is meant to be an introduction to tournament
play without a ton of the pressure.

The following rules and guidelines will apply:

Each game will be a total of 20 minutes in duration. That breaks down to **two 10-minute halves**. Please have your team ready to play and be at the field a minimum of 10 minutes prior to game time. It is important to stay on time... As these are very short games, any team not present, checked—in by the referees and ready for play at game time will forfeit the match.

Team Check-in: Teams will be checked in for the tournament 45 minutes prior to your first game. Referees will also check player cards prior to each game. All participants, players and coaches, must have CYSA player cards.

Up to 3 Guest players are allowed to participate with your team. All must have a valid recreational level CYSA player card. No competitive or "select" players are allowed to participate. Guest players must be registered in D6 for this event.

Game Play and Scoring: Each team will play four 20 minute games. The exact format for each age group will be determined once we have the final team count in each age group. Points are awarded as follows:

- 6 points for a WIN
- 3 points for a TIE
- 1 additional point for a SHUT-OUT
- 0 points for a LOSS
- 1 point for each of the first 3 goals scored
- 1 point for each Goal Differential (GD) greater than 3
 - Example: If your team scores 8, and the other team scores 2. This gives you a 6 point GD, leading to 3 points being removed from your point total.

Five team flights will play each other team in the flight, and point total will determine first, second and third places. For 4 and 6 team flights--your fourth game will be based on the points your team has accrued in your first three games. The top 2 teams in each flight will play each other for first and second place. The third and fourth team in points in each flight will play each other for third place and so on...

In the event of a tie with points and deciding who plays who, the following tie-break guidelines will go into effect:

- Head to head record
- Fewest goals allowed
- Most goals scored up to a <u>maximum of 3 per game</u>

The Home team on the schedule will be responsible for supplying the game balls, size 4 (U10 &U12). *Home team is listed first on the schedule...*

<u>U10 Teams</u>- Teams will play 7 players only. This should comprise of a goalie and six field players. <u>U12 Teams</u>- Teams will play 9 players only. This should comprise of a goalie and eight field players.



Capital Valley Youth Soccer league rules apply to all games.

The cost of this event is \$225 per team. Payment is collected online at registration for this event. Once we are certain your age group has enough teams we will notify you. Full refunds will be given to any team that pulls out, and requests a refund, via email, by September 30th. After September 30th no refunds will be given unless we are unable to get enough teams for your division. In the case that we are not able to get enough teams for your division you will be promptly issued a full refund.

This year we will provide a t-shirt for each player (but not coaches).

Only those teams that place in 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place will receive medals.

We will play rain or shine. Games will only be cancelled if there is lightning and/or the safety of all is in question.

We will do the best we can in regards to scheduling evenly matched games but inevitably, there will be mismatched games.

PLEASE DO NOT RUN UP SCORES.

Doing so may compromise your status for the remainder of the jamboree as well as being allowed into other events in the area.

There will be no exceptions and no appeals to any games and all decisions made are final.

PLEASE display sportsmanship at all times towards the referees, opposing coaches, parents and all who are involved.

If your team, coaches or parents do not display good sportsmanship, your team could forfeit as well as be eliminated from all play. You will be reported to your governing league of play.
